2. **2.43208**

$$(2 \times 1) + (4 \times \frac{1}{10}) + (3 \times \frac{1}{100}) + (2 \times \frac{1}{1000}) + (8 \times \frac{1}{100,000})$$

3. **4.20584**

$$(4 \times 1) + (2 \times \frac{1}{10}) + (5 \times \frac{1}{1000}) + (8 \times \frac{1}{10,000}) + (4 \times \frac{1}{100,000})$$

4. **2.18943**

$$(6 \times 1) + (5 \times \frac{1}{10}) + (9 \times \frac{1}{100}) + (6 \times \frac{1}{1000}) + (6 \times \frac{1}{10,000}) + (9 \times \frac{1}{100,000})$$

7. **1.72635**

$$(1 \times 1) + (7 \times \frac{1}{10}) + (2 \times \frac{1}{100}) + (6 \times \frac{1}{1000}) + (3 \times \frac{1}{10,000}) + (5 \times \frac{1}{100,000})$$
