$$(4 \times 1) + (1 \times \frac{1}{10}) + (7 \times \frac{1}{100}) + (7 \times \frac{1}{1000}) + (6 \times \frac{1}{10,000}) + (7 \times \frac{1}{100,000})$$

2. **7.33203**

$$(7 \times 1) + (3 \times \frac{1}{10}) + (3 \times \frac{1}{100}) + (2 \times \frac{1}{1000}) + (3 \times \frac{1}{100,000})$$

3. **2.35071**

$$(2 \times 1) + (3 \times \frac{1}{10}) + (5 \times \frac{1}{100}) + (7 \times \frac{1}{10,000}) + (1 \times \frac{1}{100,000})$$

4. **5.04135**

$$(5 \times 1) + (0 \times \frac{1}{100}) + (4 \times \frac{1}{1000}) + (1 \times \frac{1}{10,000}) + (3 \times \frac{1}{100,000}) + (5 \times \frac{1}{100,000})$$

5. **3.20767**

$$(3 \times 1) + (2 \times \frac{1}{10}) + (0 \times \frac{1}{100}) + (7 \times \frac{1}{1000}) + (6 \times \frac{1}{10,000}) + (7 \times \frac{1}{100,000})$$

6. **2.13646**

$$(2 \times 1) + (1 \times \frac{1}{10}) + (3 \times \frac{1}{100}) + (6 \times \frac{1}{1000}) + (4 \times \frac{1}{10,000}) + (6 \times \frac{1}{100,000})$$

7. **1.87556**

$$(1 \times 1) + (8 \times \frac{1}{10}) + (7 \times \frac{1}{100}) + (5 \times \frac{1}{1000}) + (5 \times \frac{1}{10,000}) + (6 \times \frac{1}{100,000})$$

8. **8.47507**

$$(8 \times 1) + (4 \times \frac{1}{10}) + (7 \times \frac{1}{100}) + (5 \times \frac{1}{1000}) + (7 \times \frac{1}{100,000})$$

9. **9.96462**

$$(9 \times 1) + (9 \times \frac{1}{10}) + (6 \times \frac{1}{100}) + (4 \times \frac{1}{1000}) + (6 \times \frac{1}{10,000}) + (2 \times \frac{1}{100,000})$$

10. **2.60371**

$$(2 \times 1) + (6 \times \frac{1}{10}) + (0 \times \frac{1}{100}) + (3 \times \frac{1}{1000}) + (7 \times \frac{1}{10,000}) + (1 \times \frac{1}{100,000})$$
